

2010 Course Renovations

Major Changes have occurred on all three nines during the fall of 2010. The changes, and photos of such changes are found below. SUNRISE #1

This hole has been completed in accordance with the Cooke Report. This includes the newly paving of the entire hole down the right side rough area through the green to the 2nd tee of Sunrise.

SUNRISE #2

This hole now contains a cart path that stretches from tee to green running down the right hand side of the hole skirting the driving range area. Paving is planned to finish this hole in its entirety.

SUNRISE #4

This hole now contains a cart path that stretches from tee to green running down the right hand side of the hole. Paving is planned to finish this hole in its entirety.

SUNRISE Items Remaining

To complete the changes on Sunrise, a tee extension is required on Sunrise #3, a new tee is still required on Sunrise #8 and the division of the pond on Sunrise #9 is still yet to be completed.

SUNSET #2

A major mounding and bunker complex has been added as a target to your tee shots off the left side of this fairway, approximately 280 yards from the back tee.

SUNSET #3

The completion of the mounding and cart path work connecting Sunset #3 and Sunset #4 has occurred.

SUNSET #5

The most dramatic change that occurred in 2010 course construction was on Sunset #5. This par 3 now has been framed in with mounding and bunker complexes to assist golfers with their depth perception on this hole. The water line has also changed, creating a wrapping effect that now brings water into play when missing the green to the right side. A new cart path was created during the construction phase due to the mound and bunker space required around this green.

SUNSET #6

Minor reshaping of the waste area occurred to assist in drainage of high play volume areas by the Sunset #7 green. This should help to move water back into the area that is out of play.

SUNSET #9

Minor reshaping of the greenside bunker has occurred in order to create a safer shot coming from the bunker to the green.

LEGACY #7

Legacy #7 was also a major change with a cart path that now runs all the way from Legacy #7 tee to Legacy #9 tee. The green site has also changed dramatically as per the Cooke Report. The greenside bunker that was located on the right side of the green has been reduced to a quarter of the size, creating a new run off area right of the green. A new bunker has been added to the front left side to capture balls from those that may be trying to drive the green, while a new catch bunker has been added to the area where carts use to park below the green to the right. The new cart path comes through the tree area on the left and wraps around the green for easy access.
